


Figure 2: Premises of Cyprus University of Technology




Figure 3. Ajax hotel




Figure 4. Pefkos City Hotel




Figure 5. Alasia Hotel




Figure 6. Harmony Bay Hotel

## Travel information

Two airports are operating in Cyprus in two different cities than Limassol, Larnaca and Pafos. Direct flights between different European cities and both airports are operated daily. Both airports are in a distance of around 65 km to Limassol downtown. It is suggested to use a bus (e.g. <http://www.cyprusbybus.com>) or a taxi (COST rules apply) for travel between each of the two airports and Limassol downtown. A taxi will be around 55 euro (no booking is required).




Fig. 6. Route between Larnaca Airport and Limassol downtown






Fig. 7. Route between Pafos Airport and Limassol downtown




Fig. 8. Map of Cyprus
