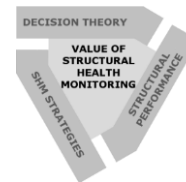

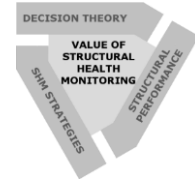

Travel to/from the airports:

Direct trains from **Gatwick Airport** to Guildford take ca. 45mins (one per hour). There is an alternative with a change that takes ca. 80 mins. Please ask at Gatwick Airport Station to find the most suitable option available at the time of your arrival. To travel from **Heathrow Airport** to Guildford use National Express coach to Woking Station.
