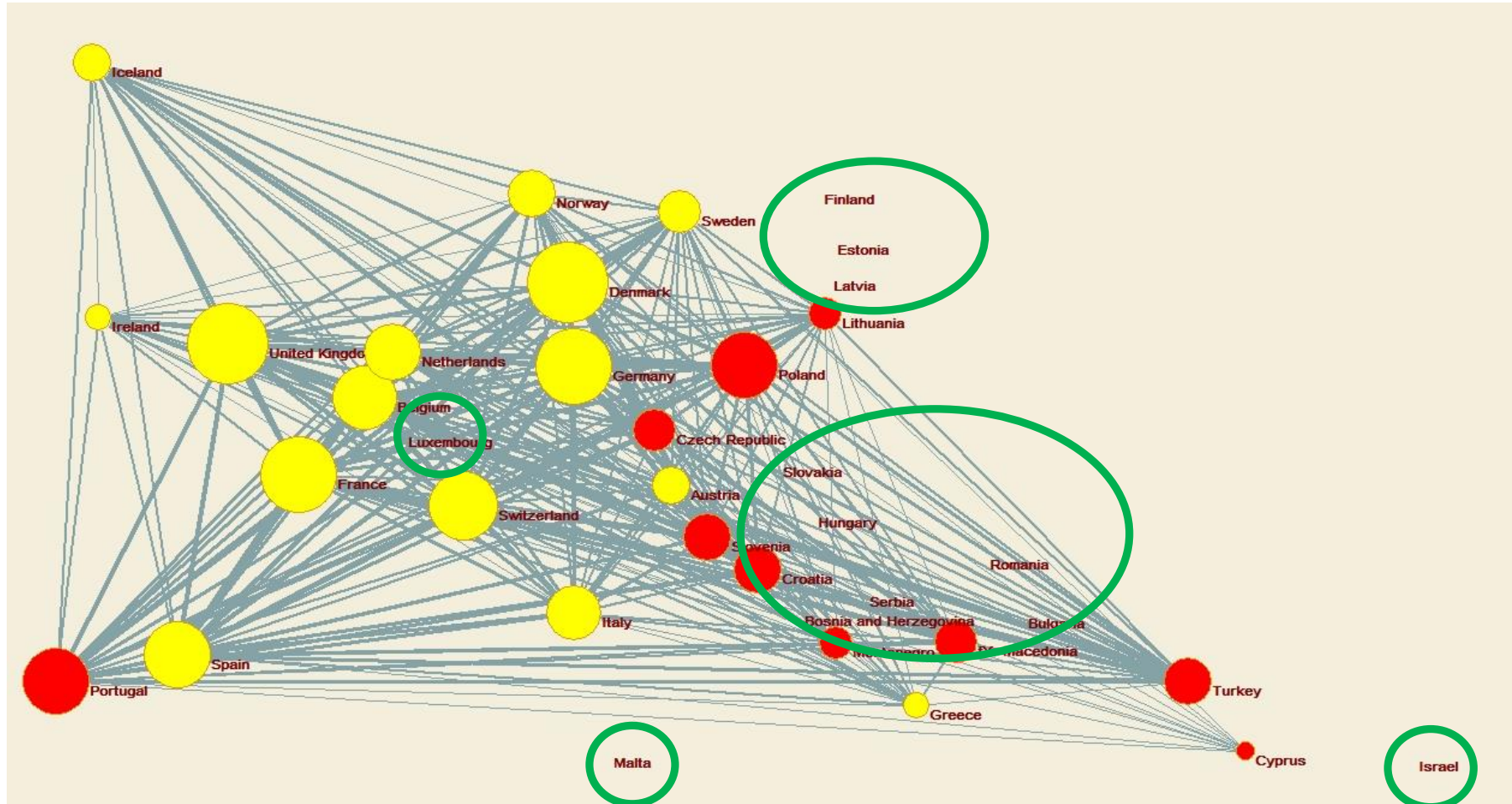

Status of TU1402: “Quantifying the value of Structural Health Monitoring”

- Timeline:
 - Started 13 November 2014, Ends 12 November 2018
- Spending status:
 - Instruments (6% spent on dissemination, 82% spent on meetings, 12% spent on STSM)
 - Cumulated Budget - 93% spending rate
 - COST policies (approx. 35% spent on ITCs, 40% spent on ECIs, 34% spent on women)

Status of TU1402: Country Participation

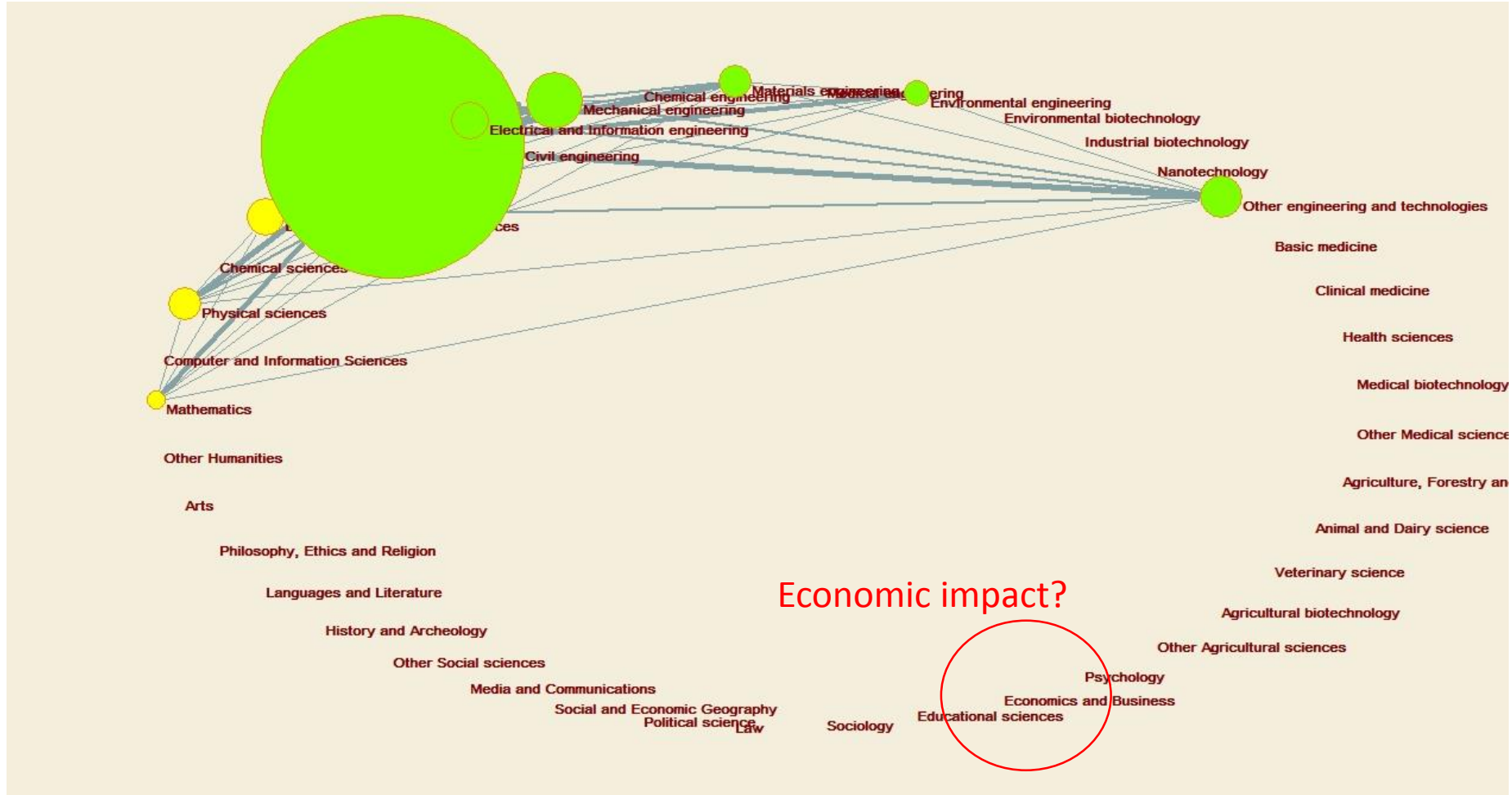

- Approach additional COST countries?
- Upcoming joint Workshop with TU1406
 - Synergies with other COST Actions? TU1208? TU1404? Critical mass?
- International visibility
 - Stimulate External Advisors: Key countries? Similar initiatives in the US? And other parts of the world? - attract attention to the world? - dissemination meetings?
- Collaboration with the industry
 - Stimulate Advisory board. European industry interest - highlight stories (website, COST etc) Users of SHM represented or included in the discussion? - STSMs as success story?

 - How does SHM affects other disciplines? ICT - Automation? Eco - CBAs? else?

Blank spots where efforts (may) need to be directed to

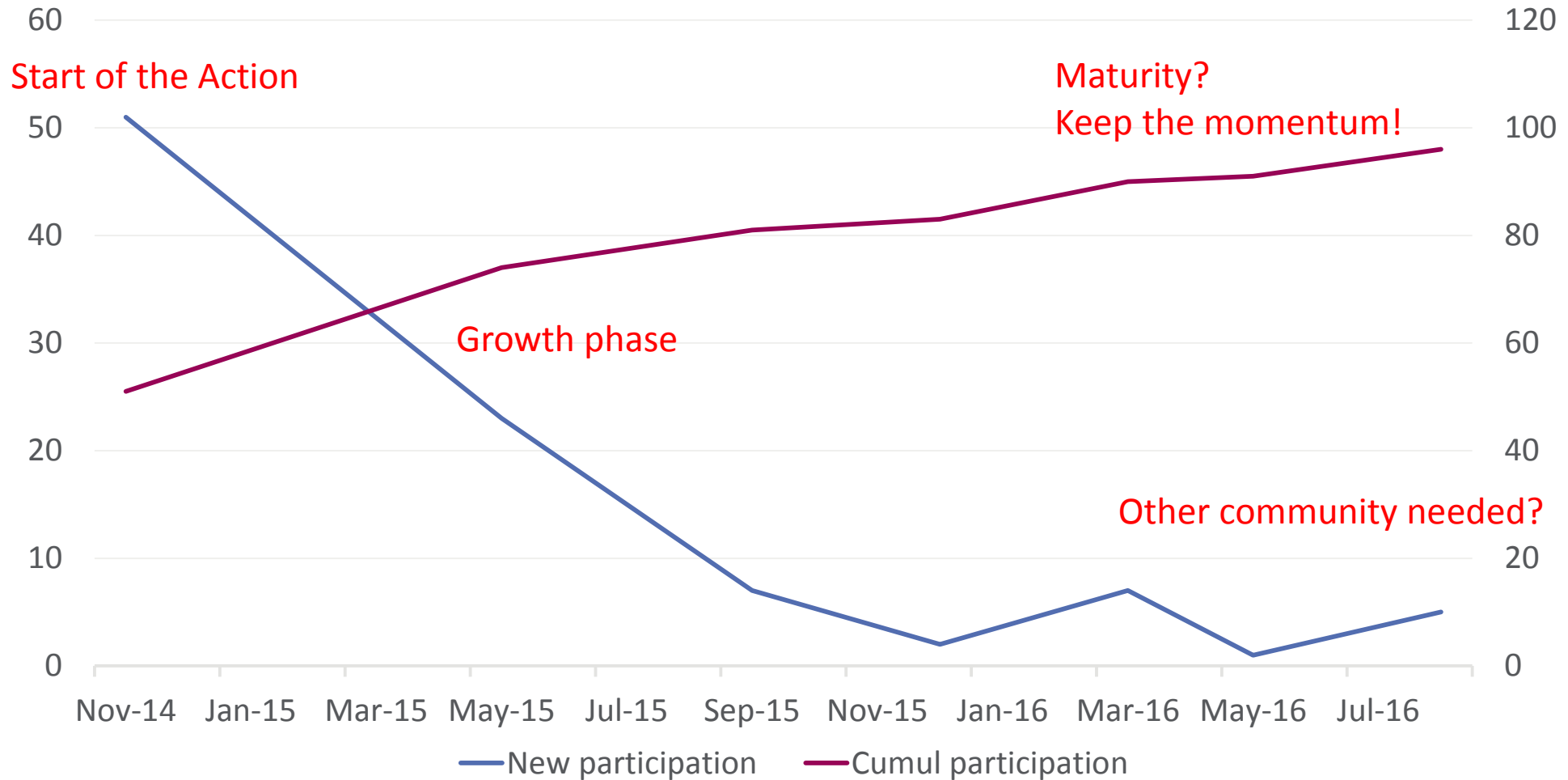
- ITCs and Gender Balance
- Promote the “uniqueness” of the Action / complementarities with existing EU initiatives / projects
- Elaborate a clear dissemination plan to be shared in the network - who does what?
 - Promotion via social media (twitter, FaceBook etc.)
 - Promotion via EU research channels in research and innovation: IGLO, EUA, LERU

 - Promotion in generalist media (impact on Europeans?)

- Strategy for stakeholder / policy involvement
 - Elaborate a Future Policy Sheet (// Future Research Sheet).
 - List EU / National actors in the field
 - Provide an impact on non-academic literature / societal value of your research
 - Input on standardisation efforts - “next steps?”
- Education channel: university pack on SHM?
